Location: Cedarview Alliance Church, 2784 Cedarview Road, Nepean, K2J 4J2

Entrance: Please use the North-side door; it's at the back of the parking lot. (Not the one facing Cedarview Rd.)

Dress: White top, black bottoms (No navy bottoms please), clean black shoes with black socks or black tights. For those in our Senior Ensembles, (OSCO,, Senior Guitar Ensemble, Senior Violin) dress is ALL black.

Name Labels: Please check in and receive the name labels from your child's chaperone at the time of arrival at the tuning area.

Please stay with your kids until the 1:15pm Drop off in their instrument area.

10:00am:

- Parent volunteers arrive at Cedarview Alliance Church.
- Cello chaperones arrive

10:15am: *Student Arrival time*****

- string students arrive. All students are shown to their areas for tuning.
- Kids are directed to their areas to find their instrument groups and chaperones to get their labels and tag instrument cases. Chaperones put one label on students back left shoulder and one label on instrument case. Attendance is not taken until 1:30. Parents are asked to stay with their child or designate another parent to take responsibility for the child until 1:30.
- Cellists will unpack instruments in Chapel. Tuning should happen in the chapel. Instruments will stay in chapel. Benches will be stored backstage as soon as tuning is complete.
