Entrance: Please use the North-side door; it's at the back of the parking lot. (Not the one facing Cedarview Rd.)

Dress: White top, black bottoms (No navy bottoms please), clean black shoes with black socks or black tights.

Sr. Ensembles (Senior Violin): ALL black

Name Labels: Please check in and receive the name labels from your child's chaperone at the time of arrival at the tuning area.

Arrival: Please arrive at 11:50 sharp, so that students are able to set settled, tune, and be ready in time for the finale rehearsal.

11:40

- Parent volunteers arrive at Cedarview Alliance Church.
- Violin chaperones arrive (except for pre twinkler chaperones)

11:50: Students Arrive (Please Note: it is very important you arrive on time in order to have proper time to tune before the dress rehearsal)

- Violin and Viola students bring their instrument to the gymnasium for tuning and leave their instruments in tagged cases. Viola students will go backstage at the assigned time and violins will go to auditorium with chaperone when the go-ahead is given by the runner. Instruments will be placed by group pieces.
- Kids are directed to their areas to find their instrument groups and chaperones to get their labels and tag instrument cases. Attendance will be taken upon arrival by the chaperones. The chaperones are responsible for students during the rehearsal and from 1:45pm onwards until the end of the concert. Attendance will be taken again at 1:50pm prior to the concert. Parents are responsible for their kids during the break and must sign out their kids after the concert.

- ❑ Please do not enter the auditorium during the rehearsal, as we want it to be a surprise for you at the concert! The chaperones will be in charge of the children. Parents can stay in the gym to enjoy games and the potluck during the rehearsal.
